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Dear Parents/ Carers,

The children are really enjoying their Ukulele lessons and are making fantastic progress.

To develop their passion further and allow opportunities to practice what they have learnt at school, the children will now be taking their Ukuleles home. The ukulele will be brought home every Wednesday after our lesson, and should be returned to school by the following Wednesday each week. As lessons are held on a Wednesday morning, it is very important that Ukuleles are in by this day in order for your child to participate in the lesson. Each child's name has been placed in the front pocket of the carry case.

When the instruments are brought home, the children will need to take great care in looking after them. This includes:

- Not placing the instrument on radiators or by extreme heat.
- Making sure that the Ukulele is not brought to public places where they can be left or get damaged.
- Not getting the Ukulele wet
- Keeping the instrument protected in its case when not being used.
- Not swapping the Ukulele that has been given with another one from school.
- Brought to school each week in the carrying case.
