a **sweet biscuit** that is flavoured with the spice **ginger**

a **strong-tasting plant substance** (usually a **seed, fruit, root or bark**) that is often used as a powder to **flavour food**

a **spice** that is used to flavour gingerbread

something which tastes **sugary** which is the opposite of savoury – gingerbread is sweet

a thick mixture of flour and other ingredients – biscuits are made from dough which **needs to be baked**

when dough is **raw**, it is soft and squidgy; when it is **baked**, it becomes harder

food that is **not cooked**

to **cook** something in an **oven** – biscuits, pastry and bread are baked
