



KEY VOCABULARY

dessert

the **sweet course in a meal**, eaten at the end of a meal

sweet

something which tastes **sugary** – the opposite of savoury

crumble

a **dessert** which is baked in the oven, made from fruit covered with a **crumbly mixture** of butter, flour and sugar

orchard

a **piece of land planted with fruit trees**, like apple trees

eating apple

an apple that is **usually eaten raw**, without cooking it

cooking apple

an apple that is **usually cooked** before eating it

vitamins

a **nutrient** that the body needs small amounts of to stay **healthy** – an apple contains vitamins

seasonality

the **time or season of the year** when a food is picked or harvested because it is ready to eat

local

food which is produced in the **area or neighbourhood close to where it is used**
